Crime Warning: Pen Argyl and **Surrounding Areas**

SLATE BELT - Slate Belt police have issued an alert to residents, advising them to secure their homes and vehicles in response to multiple reports of incidents occurring in Pen Argyl.

The reported cases involve burglaries and attempted car breakins, spanning from late November to early December. These incidents primarily occurred in the northeastern area of the borough, specifically in the following locations: the 700 block of West Pennsylvania Avenue, the 600 block of East Mountain Avenue, the first block of East Plainfield Avenue and the first block of Davey Avenue.

Authorities emphasize the importance of vigilance among residents of Pen Argyl, Wind Gap and Plainfield Township. They recommend ensuring that surveillance cameras are in good working order and emphasize the need to keep both home and vehicle windows and doors securely locked.

Those with information or surveillance video from the borough areas targeted are asked to submit a tip or call the Slate Belt Regional Police Department at 610-759-8517.
