The shakuhachi (bamboo flute) is associated with the practice of Zen Buddhism and has been played in Japan for over 1,200 years.

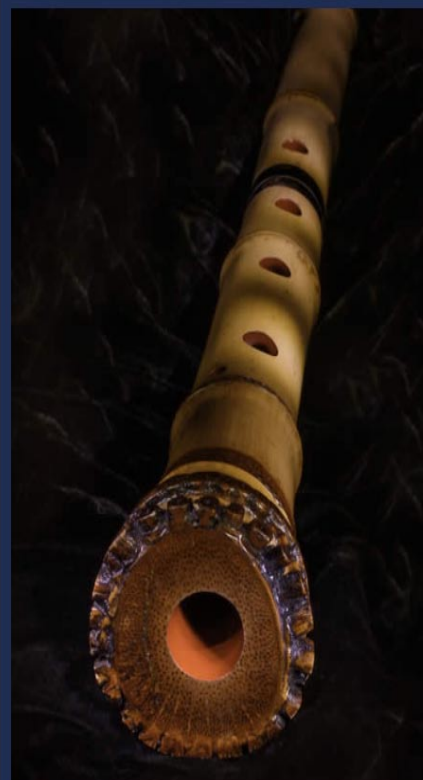
