WM Celebrates 20th Anniversary of LV Greenways at Annual Retreat with Partners!

LEHIGH VALLEY - Last month our WM team members participated alongside several partners who contributed their time, energy and input at LV Greenways Annual Retreat, held at Camp Fowler.

Together we celebrated our successes from 2023, examined upcoming project opportunities, and laid the foundation for the 2024 LV Greenways Action Plan. We also had the privilege of learning about local environmental restoration projects and recreation programs with Wildlands Conservancy, and Coalition for Appropriate Transporation, respectively.

Created in 2004, Lehigh Valley Greenways Conservation Landscape is a proactive, partnership approach to regional landscape conservation in Lehigh and Northampton counties. The diverse group of partners work together to enrich the quality of life of the Lehigh Valley citizens and visitors by providing ribbons of green throughout the two-county, densely populated area to help keep communities vibrant and connected with hundreds of miles of trails and greenway corridors.

There are four goals that help the partnership work toward a vision. They include Land Conservation and Restoration, Outdoor Recreation and Trail Connections, Community Revitalization and Local Education and Outreach.

Since 2008, WM has been an active member of Lehigh Valley Greenways with the inclusion of the acres preserved at Grand Central Landfill because of the Wildlife Habitat Certification. In 2023, the team included 12 acres in the annual report to LV Greenways as we finished up capping an area of the facility.
