Preparing Pennsylvania to Navigate AI

PEN ARGYL - With the use of artificial intelligence (AI) expanding quickly, state House Republicans are committed to navigating the challenges and maximizing the opportunities it may present.

House Republican Leader Bryan Cutler announced on Monday the formation of an Artificial Intelligence Opportunity Task Force, which will be charged with engaging experts and stakeholders to inform future legislative policy decisions relating to AI, including the human-centric ethical development of this emerging technology, along with appropriate safeguards.

Also this week, the House Republican Policy Committee hosted a hearing to enhance members' understanding of how AI technology works in our everyday lives and to discuss how to ensure the responsible use and advancement of the evolving technology. Testifiers included officials with Harrisburg University of Science and Technology, IBM, TechNet and ChatGPT.
