Happy International Women's Day! Today, and all Women's History Month, we honor those who fought for our rights before us, and advocate for our daughters' and granddaughters' generations.

That means investing in policies like expanded child care, delivering paid parental leave, and achieving pay equity. And it also means fighting to protect reproductive rights for all Americans. I was thrilled to receive a perfect score from Reproductive Freedom for All on their annual Congressional review card, and I'll continue to protect access to reproductive care, contraception, and IVF (more on this later) in Congress.

This week was a busy one in our Washington, D.C. office, and my team and I were able to welcome so many incredible constituents in to hear about their priorities and hopes for the future. I was glad to sit down with representatives from the American College of Obstetricians and Gynecologists, Pennsylvania Fraternal Order of Police, Pennsylvania Parent Teacher Association, Food Allergy Research and Education, and more. My conversations with members of our community always inform my work here in Washington.

Finally, I wanted to reassure you all that since the trail derailment in Lower Saucon Township last weekend, my team has been working with officials and first responders on the ground. I will continue to closely monitor the situation, but I am relieved that there were no reported injuries or hazardous materials threats. I will continue advocating for legislation and funding that will help us repair and maintain our infrastructure and invest in the safety of our transportation.
