ABOUT SLATE BELT RISING



2024 FIRE WEATHER AWARENESS WEEK IN PENNSYLVANIA

It's Fire Weather Awareness Week in Pennsylvania

During the spring, increasing temperatures and dry conditions, coupled with strong and dry spring winds, increase the risk of wildfires.

WILDFIRES are unplanned, uncontrolled, and unwanted fires, that are almost always started by human carelessness.

PRESCRIBED FIRES are intentionally set by HIGHLY TRAINED fire crew personnel. They are planned and controlled and provide many benefits to wildlife.

The Pennsylvania Game Commission's Wildlife Habitat Management program uses prescribed fire on state game lands and lands enrolled in the Hunter Access Program to benefit and enhance wildlife habitats. Learn more here.

Prescribed fires safely burn away "fuels," such as dried grasses and leaves, which help reduce the spread of wildfire should one occur.

Game Commission prescribed fire crews have their own slogan: "More prescribed fire equals less wildfire."
