Understanding the power of education to shape both individual lives and the world at large, the Blau and Kristof/Cruver families wanted to create something lasting—something that would encourage young people to pursue careers dedicated to solving environmental challenges. This scholarship isn't just about financial support; it's about believing in the ability of the next generation to create real, meaningful change.

Scholarship Details

The Blau/Kristof/Cruver Scholarship will be awarded to a Bangor

High School senior who plans to major in Environmental Science at a four-year college or university. The recipient will demonstrate:

- Academic Ability
- Community Service
- Strong Communication Skills

The scholarship awards \$2,500 per year, renewable for up to four years—a total of \$10,000—provided the student maintains a 3.0 GPA.

A Call to Future Environmental Leaders

Applicants must submit a typed, two-page essay explaining their passion for environmental science, past volunteer experiences, and a future idea that could positively impact the environment. Finalists will also participate in an interview with the selection committee.

Applications must be received by April 11, 2025, and can be submitted to the BASD Guidance Department or emailed to the Bangor Area School District Educational Foundation at director@basdef.org.
