Despite the attempt by some to take us back to the days of partisan gridlock, a clear, bipartisan majority in the U.S. Senate — including Sens. Fetterman and McCormick — joined those of us in the U.S. House who voted to keep the government open and deliver results that the American people are counting on. By funding the expedited deportation of criminals, supporting our military service members, and standing up for working families and seniors, we've shown what can be accomplished when we prioritize the needs of our citizens.

The bipartisan continuing resolution largely keeps the government funded at 2024 levels but also includes critical new spending, including:

#### Major investments in national security and public safety

\$485 million to help clear the backlog of deportations.

Expanded funding for cybersecurity.

\$5.8 billion for naval vessels.

\$750 million for air traffic controllers.

Support for veterans and service members

\$1.6 billion to fund the largest pay increase for junior enlisted soldiers in over 40 years.

\$6 billion in funding for veterans' healthcare.

Relief for seniors and working families

Over \$500 million for the Special Supplemental Nutrition Program for Women, Infants, and Children (WIC)

\$36 million for the Commodity Supplemental Food Program (food packages for seniors)

We still have a lot of work to do in order to deliver all of the changes that the American people deserve, but today we took yet another key step forward. I'll keep fighting to deliver on our shared priorities: securing the border, fighting for working families, and putting America First.

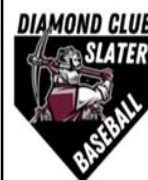
