House Passes Rep. Susan Wild Resolution Condemning Kidnapping of Ukrainian Children

This week, my resolution condemning the Russian kidnapping of Ukrainian children passed the House of Representatives with strong bipartisan support in a 390-9 vote. The Greater Lehigh Valley is home to a proud Ukrainian population, and I have spoken with many of our community leaders about the travesty of children being kidnapped by Russia.

I'm grateful that this resolution received such strong support from members on both sides of the aisle. As a member of the House Foreign Affairs Committee, I'm continuing to work to ensure that we are providing our ally Ukraine with the resources they need to fight back against Russian authoritarianism.



Congresswoman Wild Visits Child Care Center in Allentown

On Monday, I was thrilled to visit the new Community Services for Children Downtown location in Allentown to tour their new Early Childhood and Family Service center and speak with advocates and families who will directly benefit from greater access to child care. I firmly believe that every child deserves access to high-quality care and education, and will keep working to ensure that our child care providers and hardworking families have the support and resources they need.

I've heard from families and providers in our community – we must do more to expand access to affordable child care. I'm continuing to advocate for the passage of my bill, the Child Care for Working Families Act, which would ensure no family has to spend more than 7% of their income on child care, that early childhood educators earn livable wages, and that families have more child care options in their community.

Rep. Wild Writes Letter Calling for Extension of Affordable Connectivity Program

The Affordable Connectivity Program is rapidly running out of funds. So many families in our community rely on this program to help them access telehealth appointments, connect with loved ones, and log into virtual educational opportunities.

This week, I joined 158 of my colleagues from both sides of the aisle to write a letter urging Congressional leadership to extend funding for this program for an additional year. I will continue fighting to extend this critical funding for the 1 in 7 households in our district who utilize this program.

Now, I'm thrilled to be heading back home to the Greater Lehigh Valley to continue the important conversations with our community, and hear how I can best serve you in Congress.
