In addition to joining a long list of notable winners, each of the student honorees will receive a \$2,000 scholarship for college, or for honorees in grades 9-11, for participation in a STEAM program of their choice throughout the school year. Two examples are the Yale Young Global Scholars program and Summer Pre-College Programs at Stephens Institute of Technology.

All award recipients receive a beautiful stained-glass sculpture designed by artist Octavia Pena and provided through the generosity of Beall Fowler.
