Stocking Martins Creek for Trout Season

BANGOR - It's that time of year again and the anglers can't wait to get out and try their luck. The Pa. Fish and Boat team with all its volunteers were out last week stocking the Martins Creek (a class A stream) from north main street down to lower south main street in Bangor for the opening day April 3rd 8 am.

Zac Rudd, Waterways Conservation Officer in the southeast region led the team from point to point stocking hundreds of trout. Samantha Warner was on stocking truck filling buckets for all the volunteers to dump in the stream.

As an employee of the Pa. Fish and Boat Comm. she spends most of her time at Benner Spring State Fish Hatchery in Centre County where all the trout come from. The site also serves as headquarters for the Commission's Division of Production Services.

The facility consists of exterior concrete raceways, production ponds, a warming pond, and a hatchery building that contains concrete and fiberglass interior raceways, Heath tray, jar, and Buchner jar incubators. Water supply to the facility is from Benner Spring, 2 production wells, and Spring Creek.

The facility employees 11 full-time workers and 9 full-time in their Research Unit. Their average trout production is 336,366 lbs per year. It's a great place to take a tour they average 2,000 visitors annually.

So dig out your fishing poles, grab some worms and take the family out for some good times!
