The new location is at 42 N. 1st St. Bangor Borough. Services are: Sundays 10am, Thursday Bible study 7pm, Friday regular service 7:30pm.

Part of the church's mission is 'Mission of Love Food Hub' also located in Bangor at 555 N. Main St. Originally started in the basement of the old church serving 20 families a week 26 years ago has evolved into one of Northampton Counties largest food bank in the Slate Belt.

They bought the building eight years ago serving 50-80 families a week.

The county saw the need of the Slate Belt community. I started writing grants asking the county to get the infrastructure needed to expand ie. refrigeration, forklift, 16' box truck whichall we received. Our weekly family count went up to 100-150.

After numerous meetings with the county, they proposed the creation of Mission of Love to become a Food Hub of the Slate belt.

Pastor Frank and I worked out a plan to build an addition to the property of a 60'X40' building that would house a 12x12 freezer and 12x12 cooler and pallet racks to hold over 100 pallets of dry goods.

We held the grand opening for the new building on September 2023 with the county executive Lamont McClure who got us the \$350,000 to complete the project. Our average family count has risen to 275 families per week. To date the County has invested \$500,000 in Mission of Love Food Hub.

Mission of Love Food Hub is every Tuesday 8am - Noon, ID is required and is for Northampton County residents only.
