PA. - For the 23rd year, we recognize April as an opportunity to raise awareness about organ donation. In the season that represents new beginnings, we honor donors, recipients, their families, caregivers, and the clinical teams that make it all possible.

My own family has witnessed the life-saving impact of organ donation through three kidney transplants. We have seen firsthand the extraordinary generosity of others and the profound gift of life that organ donors provide.

More than 6,000 Pennsylvanians are currently awaiting organ transplants. One organ donor can save up to eight lives, and tissue donation can enhance the lives of 75 others—helping them recover from trauma, spinal injuries, burns, and vision loss.

If you aren't an organ or tissue donor yet but would like to be, there's no need to wait until you renew your driver's license or ID. It's easy to register online, and there is no cost to the donor's family. Medical professionals will always do everything they can to save a life first—donation is only considered after all life-saving efforts have been exhausted.
