

Plainfield Township Awarded 2021 Governor's Award

PLAINFIELD TOWNSHIP - Plainfield Township installed the LifeAire Systems UV Biological Remediation System at the Plainfield Township Municipal Building/Slate Belt Regional Police Station utilizing \$39,280.50 in CARES Act funds and reduced the exposure of officials, public employees, law enforcement officers and any visitors of the Municipal Building to airborne pathogens including but not limited to COVID-19, effectively assisting the township with resuming normal public service delivery and operations.

The CARES Act funds were awarded by the Northampton County Department of Community and Economic Development by way of the COVID-19 County Relief Block Grant program.

On Friday, April 2, 2021, the Township received notification that the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania Department of Community and Economic Development awarded Plainfield Township with a 2021 Governor's Award for Local Government Excellence in the category of Innovative Community/Governmental Initiatives.
