The Pen Argyl Area School District is offering a property tax rebate program. You may qualify if:

- You have owned and occupied your home during the period for which you are claiming a rebate. Rebates are granted for your primary residence only; and
- (a) You or your spouse (if living with you) were 65 years or older as of December 31, 2024; or
 - (b) You were a widow or widower during all or part of 2024 and were 50 years old or older as of December 31, 2024; or
 - (c) You were permanently disabled during all or part of 2024, and you were unable to work because of your medically determined physical or mental disability which is expected to continue indefinitely; and
- Your total annual income, including the income of a spouse residing with you, was \$45,000 or less in 2024. (IMPORTANT: only report 50% of your Railroad Retirement benefits and 50% of Federal Social Security Act benefits); and
- 4. 2024/25 Pen Argyl School District Real Estate Taxes were paid in full.
- 5. Only one member of your household may file a claim.
- Delinquent taxes DO NOT QUALIFY.

The deadline for filing an application is June 30, 2025

The Bangor Area School District (BASD) is excited to welcome the Class of 2038! The kindergarten team at Five Points Elementary School is looking forward to working with our new kindergarten class for the 2025-2026 School Year. A child is eligible for kindergarten if he/she

- ➤ is at least the age of five (5) years by August 25, 2025.
- resides within the boundaries of BASD.
- > successfully completes the district's kindergarten screening process

Kindergarten registration is online. Online kindergarten registration is available for parents and/or guardians through the district website (www.bangorslaters.com). Once packets are received and confirmed complete, BASD will contact parents/guardians to schedule a kindergarten screening appointment in June of 2025. Completed packets must be received no later than May 16, 2025, to guarantee a screening appointment in June. A completed registration includes:
