## Colleges And Universities Are Responsible For Guaranteeing The Safety And Security Of All Students

LEHIGH VALLEY - The Jewish Federation of the Lehigh Valley is concerned and alarmed by the tactics and violence we have seen at college campuses nationwide, directed at Jewish students, faculty, and staff who disagree with any of these movements.

While freedom of speech is a fundamental value, these protestors, who value their free speech, have not permitted others from dissenting their views, as President Biden said "There's the right to protest, but not the right to cause chaos".

We are concerned that the majority of these protests have morphed into platforms to broadcast antisemitism, and do not allow Jewish students to live in a safe environment, where Jewish students can attend their classes, and have the same freedoms as everyone else.

In our local community, we are in constant communication with our Hillels who have assured us that none of their activities have been disrupted by any of the protests, and do not foresee the situation changing. However, our communication is constant and open.

Colleges and universities are responsible for guaranteeing the safety and security of all students on campus, and that includes Jewish students. We hope our Universities will act accordingly in light of the protests.
