



LEHIGH VALLEY - Fresh off its approval by the Lehigh Valley Planning Commission last week, the region's first ever bicycles, pedestrian and multimodal transportation master plan is racing toward the finish line.

After an 18-month open table process that included 250 contributors from across the Lehigh Valley, the Walk/RollLV: Active Transportation Plan will go for final approval before the Lehigh Valley Transportation Study Coordinating Committee at 9 am June 3.



prepare their presentation to the LVTS, the May 27 Multimodal Working Group meeting is canceled. A partnership effort between the LVTS, LVPC, consultant Toole Design and dozens of community partners, the Walk/RollLV plan looks to change habits with suggestions that include dedicated bike lanes, pedestrian safety improvements, traffic calming and ways to better connect the region's trail and sidewalk network, linking not only the communities within the region, but connecting the Lehigh Valley to networks in neighboring regions.
