







Northampton County Donates 2018 Dodge Van to Nazareth Ambulance Corps to

Expand Mobility Services

Northampton County, PA — County Executive Lamont G. McClure and Northampton County Department of Community and Economic Development (DCED) are pleased to announce the donation of a 2018 Dodge Van 5749 to the Nazareth Ambulance Corps. This donation reflects the County's commitment to strengthening transportation access for residents and ensuring essential services reach those who need them most.

The van, which was previously operated by Children and Youth Family Services (CYF), had surpassed its useful lifecycle and was fully depreciated per CYF policy. Rather than retiring the vehicle entirely, Northampton County has opted to reinvest it into the community, continuing its purpose of service through the Nazareth Ambulance Corps' Mobility Services Team.

Funding for the donation was provided by DCED using Community Development Block Grant administrative funds to
