Rep. Wild Vows to Protect Reproductive Health Care and Fertility Treatments

In recent months, you have heard me talk a lot about the need to protect reproductive care and fertility treatments. That's because the stakes couldn't be higher – extreme, out of touch judges and politicians have made it clear that they think they know better than you and your doctor.

This week, I joined my House colleagues at a press conference to reaffirm my belief that medical decisions should be left up to patients and their providers, and that all Americans deserve the right to access the best medical technologies available to start or grow their families. As I said then, this shouldn't be a political debate – and I'm so grateful to have bipartisan support for my bill, the Access to Family Building Act, which would enshrine the right to IVF and other fertility treatments across the country.
