NAZARETH - The 2024 Jonathan P. Antonioli Memorial Scholarship has been awarded to Pen Argyl High School senio r and Jonathan's sister, Julia Antonioli. This scholarship is traditionally awarded to a student who most displays characteristics for which Jonathan was known: kindness and selflessness, generosity, and the willingness to help others. Ms. Antonioli was 12 years old when she lost her brother; she has since devoted herself to academic excellence, extracurricular activities and volunteerism that not only reflected her own personal goals, but also which honored her brother's memory.

Ms. Antonioli challenged herself with AP & Honors classes throughout high school and achieved Honor Roll all four years, as well being inducted into the National Honor Society as a junior and a senior. She received a Varsity Letter for all 4 years of high school in Track and Field; she won the Shining Knight Award in Cross Country for '23-24, broke the 200 meter sophomore record in 2022, and was part of the 2021 All Morning Call Freshman Team 100m, 200m, 400m & 1600m relay. Julia was a member of the Girls' Basketball Team throughout high school and part of the District Championship team in '23.


Julia will be attending Elizabethtown College where she will be majoring in biology.

Farmer's Market Vouchers Available for Eligible Residents

SLATE BELT - I am pleased to inform you about the continuation of the Senior Farmers Market Nutrition Program (SFMNP) by the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania. Beginning in June, vouchers worth \$50 will be available to Northampton County residents who meet the eligibility criteria. The coupons are distributed by the Northampton County Area Agency on Aging.

Northampton County residents age 60 or over who meet income eligibility (for example, \$27,861 per year for a single person in 2024 and \$37,814 for a couple) may receive the coupons. For married couples, both spouses may obtain coupons.



All persons wishing to receive coupons must present proof of age and residence. Program policies allow one to obtain coupons for another person only if they have a completed and signed a proxy form. Additionally, a person may only serve as a proxy for up to four other participants, and identification with date of birth and address of the older adult must be shown when presenting a proxy.

Persons may only receive coupons once during the program, which runs from June 1to Sept. 13. Coupons will be issued beginning on June 3and may be redeemed through Nov. 30.

This form will be available for pick-up at the AAA office (2801 Emrick Boulevard, Bethlehem), at all county Senior Centers, and on the AAA's website.
