The 1779 Sullivan Expedition, or Sullivan's March, was a major Revolutionary War campaign ordered by George Washington to devastate Iroquois (Haudenosaunee) territory in Pennsylvania and New York. Led by Maj. Gen. John Sullivan, it destroyed over 40 villages and agricultural supplies to end loyalist/Indian raids, significantly impacting Pennsylvania's Susquehanna Valley.
