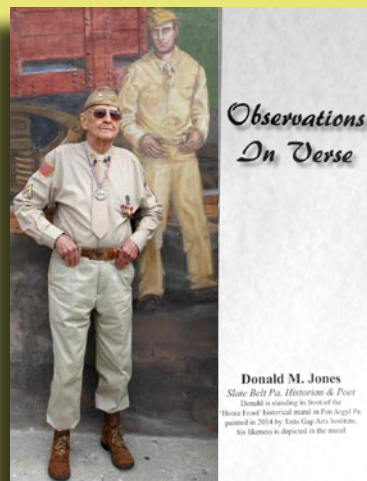

New Grants Available to Support Small Businesses

PEN ARGYL - Small businesses in Pennsylvania that were affected by COVID-19 can apply now for state grants to offset financial losses caused by the statewide business shutdown order. The COVID-19 Relief Statewide Small Business Assistance program will provide grants ranging from \$5,000 to \$50,000 to affected businesses that have 25 or fewer employees and meet other eligibility criteria.

The grant application period opened June 30 and will remain open for approximately 10 days. Eligibility criteria, application details and other information on the program are available at pabusiness-grants.com.
