Fighting for Fairness in Women's Sports

I co-sponsored House Resolution 281, which aims to advance Senate Bill 9, the Fairness in Women's Sports Act. The bill ensures only biological females are eligible to compete on girls' and women's sports teams.

Protecting fairness in women's athletics is essential. Female athletes have worked hard to earn their place and deserve a level playing field where their talent and commitment are respected.

Senate Bill 9 is a critical step toward preserving opportunities for female athletes and securing the future of women's sports in Pennsylvania.

A discharge resolution requires the support of at least 25 House members. Once the required number sign on, the resolution is entered into

the House journal, and the bill's title and committee are placed on the calendar for consideration.
