

## Property Tax/Rent Rebate Program Application Deadline Extended to Dec. 31

For those of you not already aware, the deadline to file for the state Property Tax Rent/Rebate Program has been extended to Dec. 31, 2025, allowing eligible older adults and people with disabilities age 18 and older more time to apply for rebates on property taxes and rent paid.

The maximum eligible income is \$46,520 and the maximum rebates range from \$380 to \$1,000 depending on the income level of

This legislation also ensures that eligible solar generators can qualify for state alternative energy credits, creating further savings and investment opportunities. And for those already working to get solar projects connected, our bill includes a provision that allows those applications to move forward without delay.

I believe this is a forward-thinking, cost-effective way to expand our energy portfolio, support job creation, and improve grid reliability.
