JVI LLC and the Green Knight Economic Development Corporation Host **Ribbon Cutting At The Green Knight Industrial Park**

WIND GAP - Real estate developer JVI LLC and the Green Knight Economic Development Corporation (GKEDC) hosted a ribbon cutting to celebrate the first building to be completed at the Green Knight Industrial Park (GKIP) in Wind Gap, PA. JVI purchased the approximately 4-acre lot from the GKEDC in September 2023 and recently completed construction of an approximate 49,000 square foot, 8,000 pallet ultramodern 3PL logistics facility that will be leased and operated by Trillion Sources.

JVI President Jim Vozar noted that as part of JVI's and Trillion's commitment to green initiatives, the energy efficient facility was constructed using eco-friendly and sustainable materials. The celebration marked the culmination of years of work and investment to develop the GKIP by the GKEDC and multiple economic development partners, many of whom were on hand to celebrate the opening.

GKEDC Chairman Robert Cornman recognized the commitment and diligence of the many partners who supported the GKIP including the Pennsylvania Department of Community and Economic Development and Commonwealth Financing Authority, U.S. Environmental
