Rep. Wild Celebrates Completion of ABE Terminal Modernization Project That She Pushed For

LEHIGH VALLEY - The Lehigh Valley International Airport is critical infrastructure and a key economic driver for the Lehigh Valley. Today, I was thrilled to join U.S. Secretary of Transportation Pete Buttigieg, Governor Josh Shapiro, Lehigh Valley-Northampton Airport Authority Executive Director Thomas Stoudt, and other leaders and community members to celebrate the TSA Checkpoint and Terminal Connector Unveiling!

Last year, Secretary Buttigieg and I visited the project in progress. Then, it was an active construction site. And now, it's one of the first projects to be funded, constructed, and completed by the Bipartisan Infrastructure Law. I'm proud to have secured this \$5 million Bipartisan Infrastructure Law grant and a further \$600,000 investment in ABE through Community Project Funding that I delivered for PA-07.

The project provides a new 4-lane TSA checkpoint to help expand overall capacity at ABE, and was made possible due to strong local, state, and federal partnership, and I'm thrilled to see it getting off the ground. Lv Zoo Welcomes Three Pygmy Goats To The Herd

The Trio will Join the Zoo's Current Four Goats on Exhibit on July 27

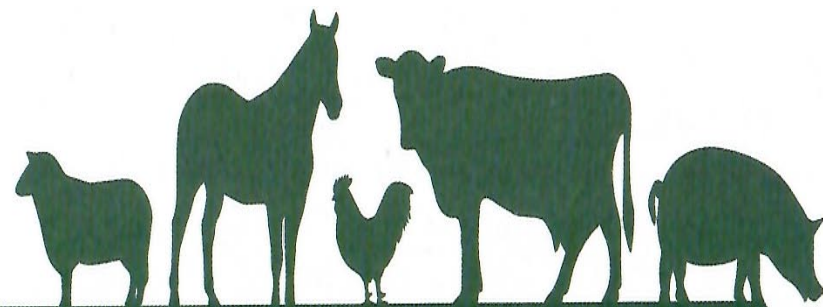
Schnecksville, Pa. — Lehigh Valley Zoo is excited to announce the arrival of three male pygmy goats. Hobart, Odin and Oliver come to Schnecksville from Rose Bridge Farm & Sanctuary in Dresher, Pa., by whom they were rescued as babies.

The trio, all approximately seven months old, arrived at LV Zoo on June 27 and had since been quarantining off exhibit for one month, during which time they received physical exams and essential vaccinations. LV Zoo's Animal Care staff has observed these new goats to be extremely playful and to love receiving attention.

Pygmy goats are a breed of domestic goat that stay small and stocky. They stand less than two feet tall and weigh 45-60 pounds when fully grown.

Hobart, Odin and Oliver increase the current herd to seven goats, joining female, Phoebe (Toggenburg goat) and males Jasper (American Alpine), Onyx (American Alpine) and Stormy (La Mancha). The three males on this list also arrived at LV Zoo from Rose Bridge Farm & Sanctuary back in September 2021.

Guests can feed the goats at any point during LV Zoo's business hours of 10 a.m. to 4 p.m. seven days a week. A handful of grain is dispersed via a vending machine for one token; and tokens cost \$1 for one, \$5 for 6 and \$10 for \$12. Tickets can be purchased at lvzoo.org.

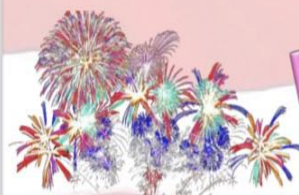
