## Brown Announces Data Center Education Policy Hearing

Recently, conversations around data center development have become more frequent. The topic is appearing in local headlines, at community meetings, and in communications to me raised by residents across our district. As this complex issue continues to evolve, so does the need for clear, reliable information and meaningful public dialogue.

That's why I have requested the Senate Policy Committee to hold a public hearing in our district, focused specifically on data centers in Pennsylvania. The hearing will take place on Monday, August 11th from 1:00 – 4:00 PM at the Valley View High School Auditorium in Archbald.

Our goal is to help local governments, residents and state government better understand data centers, their operations and what role the state plays in their development. As this issue continues to spark strong opinions, it's more important than ever that we know the facts.

I welcome residents to submit feedback or questions they would like addressed by the panels at least five (5) days PRIOR to the hearing. This is your opportunity to help shape the discussion and ensure your voice is part of the conversation and your questions may be answered. Submissions can be sent HERE.

I had the pleasure of meeting with Leslie Perryman, Executive Director of the Cornerstone Community Initiative.

Cornerstone is a brand-new non-profit here in Monroe County, focusing on wraparound reentry services and transitional housing for those being released from the county correctional facility without a home plan.

While they are not yet operational, the organization will be focusing on providing services such as mentorship, peer/recovery support, case management, education/vocation training and employment, along with supportive Housing to help people get back on their feet and be successful in the community. They aim to reduce homelessness and recidivism in Monroe County through these efforts.
