## **Investing in Our Future**

This week, I'm continuing our four-part series breaking down the "One Big Beautiful Bill" and what it means for you. We've already covered tax relief, protecting our communities, and reforming government. Now we're focused on the final pillar: investing in our future.

The budget includes an unprecedented \$50 billion investment in rural healthcare that will help keep critical facilities open and protect access to care in underserved communities. It also provides \$12.5 billion to modernize air traffic control systems, updating outdated technology, improving safety, and helping to reduce flight delays. To address the affordable housing shortage, the budget improves existing tax credits for affordable housing, which will help build over 1.2 million more affordable units over the next decade.

It also increases access to school choice by creating a new tax credit for contributions to scholarship-granting organizations, enabling new private investment in educating America's children. And it creates \$1,000 starter savings accounts for children born between 2025 and 2028, giving parents a head start on saving for their children's future.

The budget also supports American farmers by boosting research, expanding trade, and improving livestock biosecurity. It unleashes American energy by expanding leases, improving access to federal lands, and removing barriers to production. And it makes the largest investment in U.S. Coast Guard history — \$25 billion to modernize infrastructure and strengthen anti-trafficking, rescue, and maritime
