PLAINFIELD TWSP As summer is wrapping up, the team at Grand Central is working diligently to prepare for the liner placement in cell 19 of the landfill. Preparation is underway and the team is expecting to see the first two layers of a five layer liner system to be installed by the end of the month. Landfill liner plays an integral role in protecting the environment. While most would think a landfill is just one gigantic hole in the ground, it is much more complex.

Careful planning, design and multi-step ap-
