


Free Na'bodach Band At Shippen Manor Lawn 5 Pm On Sunday, August 6

Na'Bodach will present a free concert on Shippen Manor lawn at 5 pm on Sunday, August 6. Na'Bodach is Bud Osthaus - bass, whistles and vocals; Glenn Owens - guitar, mandolin and vocals; Casey Jones - Deger pipes, whistles and vocals; Mark Stewart - bouzouki, fiddle and vocals; Randy Decker - percussion, harmonicas and vocals; and Wolf Hul - fiddle and vocals. Na'Bodach explores tunes, ballads and songs of Celtic immigration to the United States. Na'Bodach visits these traditions and adapts them to modern instrumentation and musical forms.
