



# Promises Made, Promises Kept: Getting Tough on Crime

Last year, I made several promises to Pennsylvanians during my campaign. Seven months into my term as your U.S. Senator, I'm proud to share that we've already made significant progress delivering on those promises and remain committed to continuing this momentum for Pennsylvania.

Getting Tough on Crime

I promised to get tough on crime by ensuring our law enforcement have the tools, funding, and legal protections they need to do their jobs and protect our communities.

I recently voted to pass historic legislation, now signed into law by President Trump, that will protect the U.S. border and beef up law enforcement by finishing the wall, strengthening the border patrol, stopping the flow of fentanyl across the border, and getting tough on crime.

It provides \$3.3 billion to the Department of Justice to bolster law enforcement, including funds for efforts to stop the flow of fentanyl into the country and into Pennsylvania, and for grant programs which support state and local law enforcement initiatives, including Pennsylvania police departments.

# Senators McCormick & Kaine Lead Legislation to Strengthen U.S. Leadership at the Inter-American **Development Bank**

Senator Tim Kaine (D-VA) and I introduced the Strengthening United States Leadership at the Inter-American Development Bank Act, which would bolster key economic partners in the Western Hemisphere, provide more alternatives to Chinese investment, and create opportunities for U.S. companies that will create jobs in the United States.



"That's why I'm introducing this bipartisan bill with Senator McCormick to strengthen our role at the Inter-American Development Bank to counter China's influence."
