Sen. Dave McCormick of Pennsylvania calls to rebuild U.S. military

Dave McCormick doubled down on the importance of rebuilding the nation’s military and embracing technological advancements to protect soldiers and equip them for the battlefield as he toured Tobyhanna Army Depot and the Scranton Army Ammunition Plant on Wednesday.

McCormick pointed to the \$150 billion in mandatory funding for bipartisan legislation - through the One Big Beautiful Bill Act — to strengthen national defense as a step in the right direction.

“It’s important because our defense capabilities had lagged and if you look, objectively, the world is a really dangerous place,” he said. “In the first eight months of President Trump’s administration, we’ve been part of a military action against Iran’s nuclear capability and we see an ongoing battle in Europe with Ukraine and Russia. We not only need to get our defense capability back to where it should be, we need to reinvent how we go to war and how our warfighters operate and Pennsylvania should be at the forefront of the defense reindustrialization.”

McCormick, who served in the Army during the Gulf War in Iraq, stressed the nature of warfare has changed significantly since then...”
