## Supervisors Pave Way for Solid Waste Zoning District

PLAINFIELD TWSP. - After nearly 6 hours of testimony and decision making, the Plainfield Township Supervisors voted 3-2 on August 27, 2025, to expand their solid waste zoning district by 211 acres.

The Grand Central Landfill submitted an application in September 2024, requesting the Township consider three amendments. The vote last Wednesday rezoned 211 acres for the future Eastern Expansion and the additional two amendment requests made by WM are set to be part of a public hearing on September 10, 2025, which would change the designation of sanitary landfills from conditional use to a use permitted by right in the solid waste zoning district and the second amendment would exempt landfills in the solid waste district from requirements of the steep slope overlay district.

"We look forward to the next meeting in the process and working together on long-term sustainability initiatives and responsible growth for the Township," WM's Community and Municipal Relations Manager, Adrienne Fors stated.

The Pennsylvania Department of Environmental Protection would also need to approve the landfill expansion.

The public hearing for the two amendments will be held on September 10, 2025 at the Plainfield Township Fire Company fire hall at 6 p.m.
