**Visions of Eagles Grant**

It was an honor to secure \$5,000 in grant funding for an incredible local non-profit organization Visions of Eagles. Their mission is to aid individuals and families with temporary needs in the Nazareth area community. It was also a pleasure to present Sally Jablonski, Vice President, with a House of Representatives certificate to recognize their contributions to so many families in need.

"Visions of Eagles" evolved from discussions following the 45th Class Reunion of the Nazareth Area High School Class of 1962, in September of 2007. Founded in 2008, Visions of Eagles works with several other area organizations such as the Nazareth Area Food Bank, Chamber of Commerce, Nazareth Ministerium, local churches, civic groups and businesses to identify families or individuals in the area that have needs.

When recipients have been identified, "Visions of Eagles" meets with them to determine if assistance can be provided. This could include food, clothing, shelter, health care, heat, transportation, etc. If they are unable to assist, they attempt to provide information about other federal, state or local organizations that could possibly provide further support. To date, Visions of Eagles has provided nearly \$500,000 in charitable donations to the Nazareth community.
