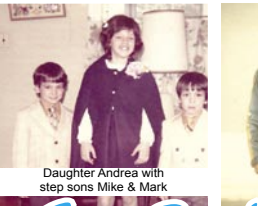

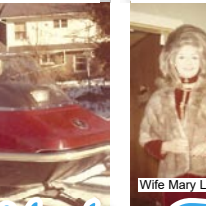

Big mistake it was in shop constantly, traded it in first year and Dad never heard the last of that one. While working for an auto dealer he drove lots of sports cars the 'Dune Buggy' was the head turner. Bill loved racing and back then it was all 'Nazareth Speedway' around here. He got to be the 'Flagman' for a few years and bumped elbows with all the drivers including Mario Andrethi his favorite racer.

He got his chance to be a race driver on snowmobiles.

his pit crew, he was known in the drivers circles as 'The Scorpion Man' he drove Scorpion sleds on oval and drag tracks. He raced professionally for a few years for John Deer snowmobiles locally.

Back when I was going to college and needed a summer job Bill hired me in as a driver at the quarry where he was Forman. He told me "you work here and see what hard labor is, you'll never drop out of college" he was right "and also don't tell Mom what you do because it's dangerous around here."

Those two summers were great, we spent 5 days a week together. Instead of just being the kid brother he would throw his car keys to for a 5 buck wash we talked and joked like old friends, oh the quarry stories. Billy loved golfing, he started at

small 9 hole in Sciota where he played leagues for years and got a trophy for a hole-in-one, he taught m at age 8. To this day it's my favorite sport because of him.

In a large family we all have our own memories these are just a few of mine. All in all, he was a revered "big brother" to his siblings and loved ones to the end and beyond.
