hibit, 67 Women, 67 Counties: Facing Breast Cancer in Pennsylvania. The exhibit, which is timed to coincide with the start of Hispanic Heritage Month, will be on display at the Bethlehem campus in the Laub Lounge from Saturday, September 14 through Sunday, September 22.

A free reception will take place on Thursday, September 19 at 11 a.m. Light refreshments will be served, and students will have the opportunity to write a message to a recently diagnosed breast cancer patient.

This unique exhibit features individuals from each of Pennsylvania's 67 counties, along with photos and quotes about how breast cancer has touched their lives. The survivors and thrivers in the exhibit exemplify the diversity of Pennsylvania, and their messages reflect the impact breast cancer can have on families and communities across our state. The photo exhibit also encourages women to learn the importance of breast cancer screenings and early detection.

Breast cancer screenings are a central focus of the PBCC, which recently advocated for the passage of Pennsylvania's Act 1 of 2023. Act 1 eliminates all costs associated (including copays, deductibles, and co-insurance) with breast MRIs, breast ultrasounds, and BRCA-related genetic testing and counseling for Pennsylvanians at high risk insured under state law.
