WM Unveils New \$48 Million Grand Central Recycling Facility in Pen Argyl, Pa.

PEN ARGYL, PA - WM announced last week that it has opened a new, \$48 million recycling facility in Pen Argyl, Pennsylvania. The Grand Central Recycling Facility is expected to process up to 120,000 tons of material per year by leveraging advanced technology equipped with automation and artificial intelligence (AI).

"WM has invested \$48 million in this facility," said Chris Farley, vice president of WM's Greater Mid-Atlantic Area, during the ribon cutting ceremony. "This plant can process as much as 120,000 tons of material a year and produce commodities that are more attractive to the mills that turn these materials into new products."


