The “Bulls and Barrels Blowout” will feature top-tier rodeo performances, including heart-pounding bull riding and fast-paced barrel racing, sure to keep the crowd on the edge of their seats. Local vendors will offer delicious food, and merchandise stands will be set up to give attendees the full farm show experience. However, attendees are asked not to bring outside food or drinks to the event.

Organizers also recommend bringing a chair, as seating is limited in the bleachers, and comfort is key for an evening of rodeo excitement.
