Sen. Mccormick Backs Gop Colleague's Criticism Of FCC Chairman's Kimmel Threat

Pennsylvania Sen. Dave McCormick has supported a fellow GOP senator's criticism of the FCC chairman's threat against Disney and ABC over TV host Jimmy Kimmel while still celebrating the comedian's — at least temporary — removal.

[Disney announced late Monday that Kimmel would return to the airwaves Tuesday.]

A column in the Wall Street Journal described Republican Texas Sen. Ted Cruz's comments about Federal Communications Commission Chairman Brendan Carr, who threatened Disney and ABC if they did not punish Kimmel for his remarks on the murder of far-right podcaster and activist Charlie Kirk.

"We had some new lows over the weekend with the MAGA gang desperately trying to characterize this kid who murdered Charlie Kirk as anything other than one of them and with everything they can to score political points from it," Kimmel said.

Kimmel also mocked President Donald Trump for his odd response to a question about mourning Kirk. Trump said he was "pretty good," but then quickly turned his attention to the construction of a White House ballroom.

"This is not how an adult grieves the murder of someone he called a friend," Kimmel said. "This is how a 4-year-old mourns a goldfish, OK?"

Carr responded to those comments by telling Disney and ABC, "We can do this the easy way, or we can do this the hard way," which was taken as a threat to retaliate against them if they did not punish Kimmel.

McCormick took to X, to comment on Cruz's remarks.

"Agree with Senator Cruz. Good riddance to Jimmy Kimmel and his disgusting rhetoric," he wrote. "Ted also raises important concerns about the comments of the FCC chairman."
