504.1.B Off street parking. Application proposes on-street or within the legal right of way parking.

504.6.A.1 Off street parking spaces. Application proposes 12 on street or within the legal right of way parking spaces. 9 off-street parking spaces are required.

508.1 Steep slopes on the site. Map showing contours at 2 foot intervals has not been submitted.

508.1.F Less than 50% of the area to be used for the building have slopes less than 15%.

508.1.K details of limitations of slope will be mitigated by the design of the structure have not been submitted.
