In September, Grand Central Landfill's wildlife habitat team presented Dan Zmoda with an appre-



ciation plaque recognizing his songbird banding and data collection work. Dan's contribution is continuing the great work previously done by the landfill's late friend and federal bird bander, Paul Karner. Dan works closely with Kevin (seen in photo) to monitor the 55 Bluebird boxes around the landfill property and report the data to the Bird Banding Laboratory when the duo bands the songbirds. This project is one of fourteen projects at the Grand Central Landfill and included in the WHC certification program. It has earned the facility Gold status- the highest achievement by the WHC.
