Pen Argyl Defeated Bangor 32-21 In The 106th Football Rivalry Game

BANGOR - Pen Argyl secured a victory at the 106th rivalry game against the Slaters, who have won the last three games in a row. Stand out Mason Soos rushed for 62 yards and two touchdowns while also throwing for 233 yards and two touchdowns and Caiden Faust contributed 92 rushing yards, one

touchdown and was awarded MVP for Pen Argyl.

The victory brought the Green Knights' season record to 7-3, the loss marked the Slaters' winless tenth game of the season. Faust set a career record this year for reaching over 2000 yards rushing and Soos passing yards was over 1000 yards.
