

House Advances Consumer Protections for Concertgoers


PEN ARGYL - I attended an ArtsQuest hearing last week to support legislation that would legally put an end to speculative ticket selling that negatively impacts concertgoers, musicians and organizations like ArtsQuest.

House Bill 1658 would generally prohibit ticket resellers from advertising or offer-


ing tickets they don't have. It also would prohibit a secondary ticket platform from using a domain or subdomain name of the specific rights holder, venue, performer, group or team unless authorized by that entity.

House Bill 1378 would prevent scalpers from using software to purchase items over the internet in bulk for the purpose of resale and not personal use. This legislation would make it unlawful to circumvent a security measure, access control system, or other technological control that enforces posted purchasing limits online.

The bills were inspired in part by last year's pre-sale for the
