EASTON - Hog Wild Eats, Music, and Fun! Located in Historic Easton, Pennsylvania, PA Bacon Fest has grown into one of the Mid-Atlantic region's most popular events.

Named one of the country's '5 Can't-Miss Bacon Festivals' (Parade.com) this two-day festival serves up delicious food, live music, family-friendly activities, cooking demos and every sort of bacon treat you can imagine.

From bacon costume contests, mascot dashes, bacon cooking battles, and a bacon-eating contest, PA Bacon Fest offers entertainment all weekend long.

The event takes over downtown Easton, centralized in Centre Square and stretching out in spokes (from Northampton and Fourth Streets to the Free Bridge, from Spring Garden and North Third Streets to Ferry and South Third Streets, and from Ferry and South Third to South Second and back to Northampton Street).

This is just one of Easton's 3 major yearly events, the other two are Garlic Fest and Clam Fest.
