## NPS Headquarters Closed for Renovations

BUSHKILL - Delaware Water Gap National Recreation Area's headquarters building on River Road in Bushkill, PA, is currently closed for renovations and will remain closed for up to a year while work is completed. During the closure, visitor services operations will be relocated to the Bushkill Meeting Center on Route 209. Pass sales, visitor information, NPS passport stamps, and the park bookstore are all available at the meeting center which is open weekdays (except federal holidays) from 8:30 am until 4:30 pm. Employees with offices at park headquarters have been relocated to other offices throughout the park's mailing address and phone numbers have not changed.

**NOVEMBER 5, 2019** 

The renovation includes a complete replacement of the existing electrical, tele-data, and telephone systems and replacement of an accessible vertical lift/elevator at the headquarters complex. The work requires a complete shutdown of electricity to the building during key portions of the renovations. The project will replace old and outdated building components, comply with current building codes, and restore accessibility to both floors of the headquarters building.

The contract was awarded to Genco General Contractors and is expected to be completed by August of 2020. A portion of the headquarters parking lot will be used as a staging area, but some parking on the south side of the site next to the rock wall has been reserved for visitors who want to hike the McDade Trail.

Building renovations are part of ongoing efforts to reduce building deferred maintenance, increase energy efficiency, and improve accessibility and safety. This project is managed and funded by the National Park Service.

## **Supporting PA's First Responders**

BANGOR - In the 1970s, there were more than 300,000 active volunteer firefighters in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania. Our volunteer emergency services were at their most robust. Before long, though, those numbers began to decline at a drastic rate. How drastic? The number of active volunteer firefighters in 2019 is closer to 30,000.

With the declining number of volunteer emergency responders reaching critical levels, we in the state House recently brought forth a "Helpers and Heroes" package of legislation designed to assist with the recruitment and retention efforts of volunteer fire and ambulance companies across the state.

The bills also respect the efforts of these emergency responders by allowing them to better use existing funds as part of recommendations made by the SR6 Commission, a 39-member commission comprised of lawmakers and a variety of fire and emergency response stakeholders.

Among the bills passed by the House this week are those that would allow volunteer fire relief money to be used for retention of existing volunteer members and providing incentives for recruiting new volunteer firefighters (House Bill 1673); make online training more readily available to current and prospective first responders (Senate Bill 146) and a host of other bills.

When our emergency services are in trouble, we are all in trouble. We in the House are committed to supporting these services and working proactively to help volunteer fire and ambulance companies every step of the way.

Bank Impostor Scam

A new scam that has emerged this summer involves criminals posing as bank representatives and offering to pick up a customer's "compromised" bank card. This scam originates over the phone with the impostor

offering to send a "senior services" agent to the house to pick up the credit card or debit card and PIN so the problem can be fixed. The crook then racks up credit card debt or drains checking accounts attached to debit cards.
