a WILD week IN REVIEW

It's November – and that means it's Rural Health Month! This month, and every month, I am committed to ensuring that all members of our community have access to high quality, affordable healthcare. As a proud member of the Bipartisan Rural Health Caucus, I am working to find common-sense solutions to ensuring our rural communities can access care and providers have the resources they need. Additionally, I'm so grateful for all the health care providers in our community who have dedicated their lives to keeping us healthy – thank you for all you do!

On the note of healthcare, I want to remind everyone that open enrollment season is here! Pennsylvania residents can access affordable health care through Pennie. For coverage beginning in 2024, be sure to enroll by January 15th! Don't hesitate to contact my office for assistance.

Recently, I joined with my colleagues in urging the Armed Services Committee to increase the basic needs allowance for our men and women in uniform. It sickens me to know that one in four active-duty service members struggle with food insecurity. When we let our service members go hungry, we are putting national security at risk. I will never stop fighting until they have the support they deserve.

You may also have heard this week about a supplemental aid package for Israel that passed through the House of Representatives. It was with sadness that I voted against this bill: because the House GOP chose to condition aid to Israel in that bill, which sets a dangerous precedent I can't get behind. Conditioning national security assistance on domestic policy issues delays urgently needed aid and undermines America's standing in the world, just to score cheap political points.

Believe me, I'm continuing to push for a robust, bipartisan aid package to provide security assistance to Israel, necessary humanitarian assistance for civilians in Gaza, and support to our allies around the world, including Ukraine. We must meet the seriousness of this moment, and I urge GOP leadership to quit the political games.

Finally, on a lighter note, I wanted to update you all on the results of a poll my office conducted this week on Daylight Savings. Of more than 5,000 responses, 75% of respondents wish to see Daylight Savings time be made permanent, and 25% prefer changing the clocks with the season. What do you prefer?

Rep. Wild Hosts Roundtable to Discuss Need to Pass Supplemental Child Care Funding

This week, I was thrilled to join child care providers and parents at the Greater Valley YMCA, Bethlehem Branch for a roundtable discussion on what a lapse in child care funding would mean for them. Hearing their stories reinforced what I've said time and time again – that high-quality, affordable child care is necessary to allow working families to reach their full economic potential.

I am glad that the White House has requested \$16 billion in supplemental funding to extend child care grants from the American Rescue Plan for an additional year. I have been calling for this extension, and I will do everything I can to see that this funding passes.
