It's been another busy week here in Washington! First, I would like to thank everyone who made their voice heard and voted in Tuesday's election. Voting is the bedrock of American democracy, and I am grateful to the volunteers and election officials whose hard work helped facilitate the democratic process in our community.

This week, I wrote a letter with my colleagues urging Congressional leadership to pass supplemental child care funding. Key child care funds from the American Rescue Plan expired in September, leaving hundreds of thousands of children in our commonwealth at risk of losing care. I will continue fighting to ensure that all children have access to the care they need to thrive and that working parents have access to the support they need to reach their full economic potential.

Once again, Congress is unfortunately rapidly approaching a government shutdown. We have just over a week until the stopgap solution keeping the government open expires, and we need real solutions to prevent a shutdown. Unfortunately, the House GOP insists on playing politics with government funding -- and instead of working in a bipartisan manner, is failing to pass even their own appropriations bills. I have heard from individuals in our community who would face the devastating impacts of a government shutdown, and I am working to engage my colleagues across the aisle to find a bipartisan path toward keeping the government open. As the proud daughter of a career Air Force officer, I understand the unique challenges our military members and their families face.
