



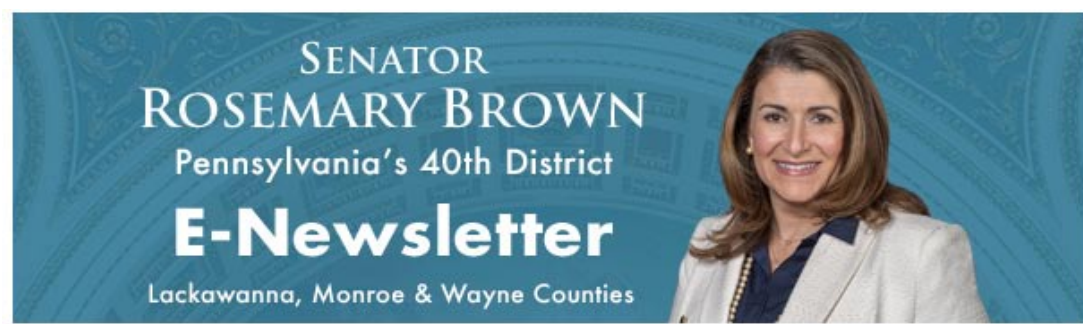
Bangor: Voluntary Conservation Order

BANGOR - This is an important notification from Pennsylvania American Water. A voluntary conservation notice has been issued as of 12:00 PM on 11/14/24 for customers in Bangor Borough, Roseto Borough, Washington Township., Plainfield Township., Upper Mount Bethel Township to reduce water usage.

We ask that you voluntarily limit all non-essential water use until further notice. Please use the following schedule for outdoor watering needs. If your street address contains an even number, please water on even-numbered dates. If your street address contains an odd number, please water on odd-numbered dates. When conditions improve, customers will be notified when the conservation notice is lifted. If you are a landlord and water service is in your name, please inform your tenants so they are aware of this impact to their water service.
