Election Integrity Wins in PA Supreme Court Decision

The Pennsylvania Supreme Court last Monday ordered counties not to count mail-in ballots that lack a correct handwritten date on the return envelope as part of the automatic recount in the close U.S. Senate race between Sen. Bob Casey and challenger Dave McCormick.

The court's ruling not only upholds the rule of law but is also in line with the clear and plain reading of the Election Code and several past court decisions upholding the validity of requirements for filing absentee and mail-in ballots.

Following the law is essential to ensuring free, fair and accurate elections. I applaud the court's decision and am committed to advancing policies, such as voter ID, that will further ensure the integrity of our elections.

Casey conceded the race to McCormick Thursday evening, and the automatic recount has been halted.
