Emergency Fuel Assistance Program

The Northampton County Area Agency on Aging has begun its 2024 Emergency Fuel Assistance Program. This program is for oncea-season fuel assistance of \$800: \$780 goes toward fuel assistance and \$20 goes to Project of Easton for administrative costs.

To be eligible, an individual needs to be 60 years of age or older, reside anywhere in Northampton County EXCEPT for Bethlehem City, must meet Department of

Housing and Urban Development (HUD) income guidelines, provide proof of household in-



come, and the fuel tank needs to be at 1/4 full or less. Proof of residency is also required with a copy of the current lease, a letter from the landlord and two pieces of mail, one of which is a bill.

For assistance with non-oil heat, a shut-off notice is required. Low Income Home Energy Assistance Program (LIHEAP) benefits need to be exhausted, or the applicant needs to have been denied LIHEAP benefits, before they can be eligible for this program.

When a referral is received, a Northampton County Area Agency on Aging staff person will schedule a home visit to determine eligibility.
